**Terry and Nancy Sullivan**, missionaries to Benin, Africa will be sharing in our morning worship service this Sunday. Benin is a small country on the west coast of Africa, sandwiched between Togo and Nigeria. Terry and Nancy, have been missionaries there for 20 years, working with Wycliffe Bible Translators, translating the scriptures into one of the common languages of the people there. I want to encourage you to join us this Sunday as Terry and Nancy inform us of the work to bring the Word of God to the Benin people.

**ManUp** is designed to minister to and involve the men of our church in ministry. ManUp will be meeting on Thursday, September 12, at 6:00PM in the fellowship hall. A meal will be provided for a donation of any amount, and we ask that all men planning to attend signup so that we will be able to prepare enough food for everyone attending.
